# **Micah's Caring Initiative**

Our Micah's Backpack Program for the 2022-2023 school year has come to an end. Year to date we have packed 7,604 bags of food, delivered 45,624 meals and handed out more than 106,456 items of food. This is enough food to feed one person, three meals a day, for



more than 40 years. That, my friends, is a lot of food.

As most of you know, Pastor Michelle recently submitted her resignation. Her last day in the pulpit will be June 4.



After worship that day, we will say farewell and celebrate her ministry with us at the Coffee Hour Fellowship. Her last day in the office will be during the week of June 12-16.

The Council asked the Virginia Synod to provide an interim pastor. To bridge the gap between Pastor Michelle's time with us and the arrival of our interim pastor, a supply pastor will preach each Sunday. Additionally, the Virginia Synod will provide Pastor Bill King as our vice pastor. That is, he will perform pastoral duties other than preaching.

We'll provide information on the call committee process in the near future.
