In September we sang from All Creation Sings, #1000, God's Work, Our Hands (hymn tune-Earth and All Stars).



### **Sharing the Story of Micah's Caring Initives**



Each week we are packing around 300 bags. During the months of September and October we packed a total of 1,900 bags of food for children in 10 local schools. 26,614 food items have been distributed to help address food insecurity in our community.

Our volunteer base continues to remain strong. The VT Women's Tennis team, cadets from the ROTC, The Blacksburg Rotary Club and

several fraternities and sororities packed with us during the month of October. It is wonderful to see people from all backgrounds come together to support our mission.

The MR Real Estate Team in Blacksburg hosted a food drive for us on Thursday, Oct. 12th. The drive brought in 500 food items to fill our shelves.

Soup for Seniors continues to pack and distribute approximately 90 bags to the seniors at Warm Hearth Village. We will be packing the bags at St. Michael on November 27th at 10:00 a.m. We encourage any new volunteers to help us pack and deliver at that time. Mark your calendars that we will be packing on December 19th. We will continue to a little something extra in the bags every other month. In December we will be collecting Footie Socks with

grips.
