Notes on the 2012 Investments in Ministry

Thank you for your investment in the ministry of God at St. Michael. With your generous stewardship of God's gifts to you, St. Michael's ministry continues to grow. Overall giving to the ministries of St. Michael including gifts to support the Core Ministries like Worship, Youth and Shepherding, the Micah's Backpack Fund, the Justice and Mercy Fund, the Facilities Expansion Fund and the Property Maintenance Fund is strong.

Based on your estimates of giving for 2012 and established giving patterns, the Council prepared an investment plan that will support expansion of our ministries, recognize the excellence of our staff and increases our support for Micah's Backpack. The Council expects giving to the Core Ministry Fund in 2012 to increase by 3 to 4% and therefore has projected investing an additional 3% in our Core Ministry areas including a 2% raise for members of the staff, the addition of retirement assistance for long-term, part-time employees through a 3% matching contribution to a retirement account, plus an additional one hour per month of administrative support. The proposal includes a 3% raise for Pastor John and by redistributing Pastoral Support into areas of mileage reimbursement and continuing education, the congregation will save on insurance costs and Pastor John will receive additional tax savings.

In the last year, St. Michael has expanded our ability to help God's people in need through various partnerships and we look forward to adding new partnerships in the future. The partnership with Lutheran Family Services of Virginia, Virginia Lutheran Homes and Luther Memorial provides needed grief support services in the New River Valley and the Support U Caregiver Class. The expanded ministry partnership with Campus Ministry has increased the participation of Pastor Bill King in the ministry of St. Michael. The addition of staff support for Micah's Backpack will allow St. Michael to more effectively manage the over 70 community partners who support Micah's Backpack.
