## Soup For Seniors Program

In June 2012 Warm Hearth Village partnered with St. Michael's Lutheran church to offer the Micah's Soup for Seniors program. The program's goal is to provide nutritious, easy-to-prepare meals for seniors living on low fixed incomes. Each month volunteers from St. Michael's prepare groceries for monthly deliveries to the Trolingers and New River House. Approximately 90 residents participate in the program. The monthly distribution time is more than just a delivery opportunity. It provides time for volunteers

and residents to connect with one another, and has created a stronger fellow-ship with the greater community for residents at Warm Hearth Village.



The program has received support from various groups in the community, including the local AARP, Mt. Tabor Ruritan Club, and Virginia Tech students. Recently, Boy Scout Troop 348 from Riner conducted a food drive for the

program. The scouts received donations that filled three cars. The food will be distributed in the coming months at Warm Hearth Village.
