## **CARING CONVERSATIONS**

Discuss in your household or small group:

- Share about a time when you said goodbye to someone.
- Imagine being present when Jesus ascended into heaven.
  Describe what you think might have taken place.
- The Bible tells us that Jesus has gone into heaven to rule over all (Ephesians 1:20-21). What does that mean for your life, for the world, for the future?

## **DEVOTIONS**

Before Jesus ascended into heaven we are told that he "lifted up his hands and blessed them." As part of your household devotional times this week, bless one another using this week's Taking Faith Home "Blessing to Give." Place your hands on one another's shoulders or heads as you say the words of blessing.

# **SERVICE**

At his Ascension, Jesus was "lifted up" into heaven. We sometimes talk about being "lifted up" emotionally by experiences we have in life. For instance, the encouragement of others is uplifting for us. Share about people who have encouraged you or brought you joy. In celebration of Jesus' ascension, make and decorate cloud shaped cards to send them. Say a prayer of thanks for the ways they have helped or served you. Talk together also about people you know who may need some particular help or encouragement at this time. Discuss ways in which you can support them.

# **RITUALS AND TRADITIONS**

Arrange for some balloons to be filled with helium at a local party shop. Think of as many words as you can to complete this sentence: "Jesus fills us with \_\_\_\_\_\_." Write these sentences onto the balloons with a permanent marker. Release them in the rooms of your home in celebration of Jesus' ascension. If you do not have access to helium gas, cut up white poster board into cloud shapes and hang these up around your home.
