CARING CONVERSATIONS

Discuss in your household or small group:

- Share about a time when you wanted to be first in something.
- Jesus said that following him involves putting the needs of others ahead of our own. In what ways did Jesus set an example of this for us?
- In what ways do you serve others in Jesus' name? How has serving others brought good to you?

DEVOTIONS

Jesus said, "Anyone who welcomes one of these little children in my name welcomes me." (Mark 9:36) In your home devotion times this week, make a special point of praying for children in your church and neighborhood. Ask for God's help to welcome them with the heart and spirit of Jesus.

SERVICE

Jesus said to his disciples, "Whoever wants to be first must take last place and be the servant of everyone else." Make a list of ways you can be servants to one another in your household this week. Decide together on particular things you will try to do for one another. Monitor your progress during the week.

RITUALS AND TRADITIONS

September 21 is the United Nations' International Day of Peace. Discuss how your household can contribute to making the world a more peaceful place. Make a list of situations or places that are in need of peace. Light a candle for each one and say a short prayer beginning with these words: "Lord Jesus, Prince of Peace, please bring your peace to ______."
