Goal: To be known for Faith Formation among children and youth in ways that encourage belonging and build relationships

- Increase the voice of children, youth and their families at St. Michael in planning, implementing and evaluating ministry
- Increase the scope and depth of leadership opportunities for youth
- Increase participation of children, youth and their families at St. Michael in worship, education, activities and ministries
